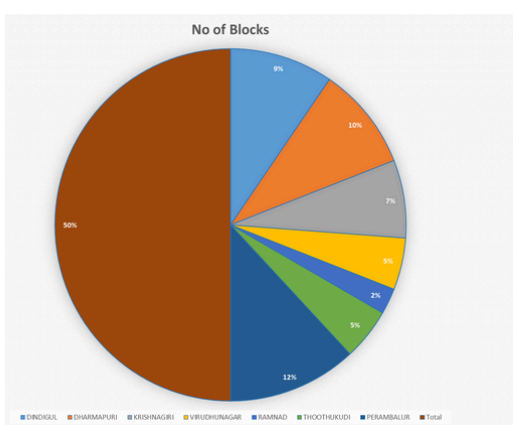


AGRICULTURE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

1.1. Integrated Watershed Management (IWMP)

Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP) is implemented by Department of Land Resources of Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India. Objectives of watershed development projects are to improve productive potential of rainfed / degraded land through integrated watershed management; to strengthen community based local institutions for promotion of livelihoods & watershed sustainability, and to improve the efficiency of watershed projects through cross learning and incentive mechanism.

Coodu Trust, as a coordinating agency had conducted training and exposure visit at KVK ,Gandhigram,TNAU Coimbatore,TNAU ,Killikulam and Horticulture college,Periyakulam to enhance the knowledge in modern agriculture . The participants were from watershed committee, watershed beneficiaries and SHGs members from Pudukottai,Ramnad,Virudunagar,Perambalur,Dharmapuri,Krishnagiri and tutucorin district The training topic were Roles & Responsibility of watershed committee, soil and water conservation techniques, Skill development training on micro enterprises, Vermi composting, organic forming, micro irrigation for field crops etc. Totally 3021.farmers were trained and the details of farmers trained are as follows

1.2 Farmers Producer Organisation(FPO) Promotion

Government of India has launched a Central Sector Scheme on Formation and Promotion of 10000 Farmers Producer Organization (FPOs) to ensure economic of scale for farmers; Towards the achieving the goal of creating FPOs under Central Sector Scheme

COODU TRUST empaneled as CBBO for the promotion of FPO in Dindigul and Thiruvarur district by TNSFAC is in the process of promotion of FPOs in Oddenchatram and Kodaikkonal area of Dindigul district and Vaduvur and Kottur area of Thiruvarur district.

The names of the FPOs promoted are as follows

Dindigul District - Oddanchatram Agro Farmer Producer Company Limited at Abilikkai, Oddanchantram Block and Kuriji Malai Farmer Producer Company Limited at Poondi, Kodaikanal Block.

Thiruvarur District : Delta Vaduvur Agriculturist Welfare Farmers Producer Company at Vadavur, Needamangalam Block and Ponni Vanam Farmer Producer Company Limited at Kottur, Kottur Block.

Totally 1082 farmers were mobilized and enrolled as members in 4 FPOs. In Oddenchatram- 300 Farmers, Kodaikkanal -100 Farmers, Vadavur-365 farmers and Kottur-317 farmers. In the FPOs,257(24%) women members in 4 FPOs. The business activities identified are

Training and exposure on Agri export, post-harvest management, Food processing, and Agricultural Marketing development activities provided by the key experts. All the FPOs got Equity grant for their business and started their business

The progress report has been submitted to TNSFAC on time.



1.3 Promotion of FPO through State Balanced Growth Fund

The State Balanced Growth Fund is a unique programme to address regional imbalances in terms of per capita income, employment, poverty, health, education and gender issues

The State Planning Commission has been identified us as the coordinating agency to implement Sustainably Livelihood Enhancement through Scientific Management of Dairy Animals project at Kadavur Block, Karur District and 100 Joint Liability Groups formed. .In kadavur block, Thanragampatti Dairy Farmers Producer Company Limited was promoted with women farmers to promote dairy based activities with 500 women farmers

Under this programme ,training on dairy farming has given to 260 women farmers and 10 milk collection centres were established and 1800 litres milk collected daily from the women and milk is marketed through Raj Dairy milk .Weekly payment is made to the beneficiaries.Now the women are getting a minimum of Rs.32 /liter to a maximum of Rs.45 /liter as per the SNF value.We have approached SBGF for loan to 500 Milch animals with subsidy

During this year, separate vehicle for transporting the milk with the support of Karur Vsya Bank, Karur.



CSR Activities

2.1 Rain Water Harvesting (RWH) Activities - ATC Tyres - UWM

We have implemented the Rainwater Harvesting activities to improve the livelihood of farming community under CSR activities supported by ATC Tyres through United Way, Mumbai in 18 villages of manur block of Tirunelveli District.

Capacity building training programmes on agriculture and animal husbandry were conducted and following activities were implemented Recharge shaft -67 nos ,baby ponds -25 and Trench Banding 90 meters were completed. Besides 41250 trees (Palmyrah,mango,Sappota,tamarind ,Lemon and other horticultural plants) were planted in the tank area and in the farmers land and fruits cultivation practices were imparted to the farmers through demonstration.13 user groups have formed in the 13 villages The impact of the programme is quite encouraging ,63000 farmers were benefitted through this programme 200.10 crores liters of water has additionally stored .The water table has increased to 5-10 feet's and the farmers doing three time cropping instead of one or two crops per year.The cultivable area has increased by 30 %



2.2 Rain Water Harvesting (RWH) Activities - Krishna Mines

With the support of KRISHNA MINES, the following activities have been implemented in Manur block of Tirunelveli district under rain water harvesting restoration of water bodies

- Capacity building and awareness creation on Rain water harvesting
- Training on agriculture and animal husbandry
- Desilting of 7 tanks
- Recharge shaft -21
- Tree plantation-5600 (Palmyrah,mango,Sappota,tamarind ,Lemon and other horticultural plants) were planted in the tank area and in the farmers land
- 7 user groups have formed in the 5 villages
- 6062 farmers benefitted through this activities

The impact of the programme is quite encouraging ,6062 farmers were benefitted through this programme 21.95 crores liters of water has additionally stored .The water table has increased to 5-10 feet's and the farmers doing three time cropping instead of one or two crops per year.The cultivable area has increased by 25-30 %



2.3 Rain Water Harvesting (RWH) Activities - TATA Power

With the support of TATA Power, the following activities have been implemented in Manur block of Tirunelveli district under rejuvenation water bodies

- Capacity building and awareness creation on Rain water harvesting
- Training on agriculture and animal husbandry
- Desilting of 7 tanks
- Recharge shaft -22
- Tree plantation-4460 (Palmyrah, mango, Sappota, tamarind, Lemon and other horticultural plants) were planted in the tank area and in the farmers land
- 5 user groups have formed in the 5 villages 8054 farmers benefitted through these activities

Watershed Development - Ever send enterprises CSR Activity :

Under Corporate Social Responsibility of Ever send enterprises had supported to complete the watershed development activities at Thirunelveli District. There were two activities were taken for Watershed Development one is community mobilization and institution building. In this activity, 100 farmers were mobilized into watershed development area as beneficiaries. Among them 30 farmers were formed watershed development committee, they were trained on cultivation technologies of crop and livestock management. And second one is water resource development activities of 9200 trees were planted in waste land and watershed catchment area, and water reservoir and small water recharge shifting activities were done and 6 ponds were desilted for increasing the water holding capacity.



2.4 School Adoption (SAP) and Village Adoption (VAP) Programme - ATC Tyres through UWM

DEEN DAYAL UPADHYAYA GRAMEEN KAUSHALYA YOJANA (DDUGKY)

The Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD) announced the Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) with the dual objectives of adding diversity to the incomes of rural poor families and cater to the career aspirations of rural youth. DDU-GKY is uniquely focused on rural between the ages of 15 and 35 years from poor families.

Coodu Trust as Project Implementing Agency (PIA) completed the rural youths on skill training programme at Karur District and empanelled as training partner in NSDC and TNSDC .

During 2022-2023, 124 numbers of youths were training in Sewing Machine operators course . Out 124 trained youth, 120 trained youth were placed for job in the reputed industries in Suprime Industries, Mithra, SJ Catering College and V.T. Skill Training Institute etc.

Out of 624 total trained, those trained 586 women were placed in the reputed industries like Aisan Fabric Private Limited , Imayam Garments , Mithra Enterprises and Supreme Industries respectively.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING (NRUM)

Our COODU Trust had conducted the youth skill training with the support of State Government . Under National Rurban Mission, our trust implemented the Sewing Machine Operators training to 20 women in Thirunelveli District. And out 20, 11 beneficiaries were got job opportunities in private company remaining 9 women started self-employment.



SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING (TAHDCO)

COODU Trust had completed the skill training under TAHDCO at Maylampatti , Karur District. 12 SC women were trained in Sewing Machine operator course for 3 months. After completion, all 12 members were tied up with Karur private company for job.

SKILL TRAINING PROGRAMME UNDER SJ COLLEGE :

With the approval from, Manonmaniam sundaranar University, we are conducting Courses on DMLT (2Years), GDA(2Years), Fashion designing(1Years), Assistant Chef(2Years) and 56 students are studying in these courses

During this year through hotel management training 9 youths placed in Adayar Ananda Bavan Hotel and Royal Hotel with good remuneration and 11 women were trained in Beautician Training in which 5 got job at LOD Beauty Baler & Rubee Barlar and the remaining are running own parlours.



SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING – SUPPORTED BY GURU KRIPA ENTERPRISES AND NAVIRUD ENTERPRISES CSR INITIATIVES

Coodu Trust has organized and completed Sewing Machine operators Training to 25 women and Accounts Assistant Using Tally Training to 30 youths at Suthamalli, Tirunelveli District. Out of 55, 37 got job at private companies' rest of 18 members had started self-employment work. For this training programme Guru Kripa enterprises and Navirud Enterprises supported to complete the task.



Water Quality Testing Lab & JJM – FTK Training – TWAD

COODU Trust had taken two programme from Tamilnadu Water and Drainage – (TWAD) and implemented the activities in Thirunelveli, Sivagangai, Virudhunagar, Theni and Dindigul District

Setting up of Water Testing Lab

- As per the TWAD instruction, the COODU Trust had setting up the Water Testing Labs at District level. In that lab, Trust had appointed the following persons of Chemist, Sample testing person, Lab Assistant , Lab attender and Data entry Operator for completing the water test at Lab level and in each lab 3000 samples were taken from the villages and tested.

Jal Jeevan Mission(JJM) FTK Training

For creating awareness among the community on the water quality Training on water testing by using FTK kit, COODU Trust had conducted FTK water testing training at District level. Panchayat representatives, Tank Operator, SHG federation members were attended the training and program at district level. In Sivagangai District – 360 members, Virudhunagar District -390 members, Theni District – 222 members and Dindigul District – 300 members totally 1272 members were trained on water testing using FTK.



Environment Awareness Programme

ENVIRONMENT AWARENESS PROGRAMME

Awareness Programme of Tree plantation was conducted at School level at Kadavur Block Tharagampatti . 4 awareness programme was organized at school level totally 400 students actively participated and same day tree plantation work was done at road side and waste land area. Beside the students were given saplings for planting at their home premises place.



Other Programmes

AMBULATORY & MORTUARY SERVICE

Coodu Trust is running Ambulatory & Mortuary services for helping the people who are in need of emergency medical services and through this service 245 persons were utilized these services.

YOGA CAMP

We have Yoga Camp organized on December 2022 at Dindigul for 7 days . Totally 286 members participated and learnt simple yoga exercises.

DE-ADDICTION / SHORT STAY HOME

We are running De-addiction short stay home at Tharangampatti for the drug addiction youths. They were given better treatment and counseling from the addiction. This year 57 persons were stayed at home up to recover from the de-addiction habits.

SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

To engage in corporate social responsibility CSR means that, in the ordinary course of business, a company is operating in ways that enhance society and the environment instead of contributing negatively to them. In this process Renault Nissan Automotive Indian Private Limited (RNAIPL) has interested and involved CSR activity at Padappai Pamchayat, Kanchipuram District.

Coodu Trust had involved and completed the one of the CSR activities of erection of ECOMIC Machine at Padappai and Urapakkam Pamchayat, Kanchipuram District. Besides, in this panchayat solid management awareness campaign was conducted Village level on Social Engineering, IEC and monitoring and branding activities etc. And Village sanitary workers of sweepers, drivers and other helpers were trained maintenance follow up activities.

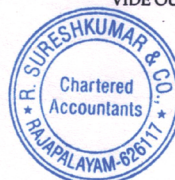
